

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Report II 30days Report
CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENT APPROPRIATIONS
ACT(CRRSAA), 2021

Grace Mission University (OPE ID: 041578-00) received education stabilization funds under Section 354(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (“CARES Act”), Public Law No: 116-136. This Fund Report applies to the student portion received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

We take receipt of these federal funds seriously and are distributing them in accordance with the CARES Act and implementing guidance.

The institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The institution has used the funds received \$30,614 under Section 354(a)(1) HEERF II (CRRSAA) to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.

1. The institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 354(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.

7. Any instruction, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the emergency financial aid grants are provided

Method Used: Financial aid staff confirmed all active students at Grace Mission University met the following

Criteria:

- Student have been enrolled in classes in the spring semester on February 2, 2021
- Student must apply the FAFSA for year 20-21

Eligibility Amounts and distribution of the funds:

We will equally distribute the funding to each financial aid. Every eligible student will receive \$500.00.

There is no application required since all financial aid applicants are qualified to receive the fund.
